IM2 Phase III (2010-2013): Constraints

- IM2-III budget: 40% of the IM2-II budget....
- Consolidating IM2-II achievement:
 - Scientific achievements, active collaboration, and structural impact (current and future)
- Reassessment of future research directions
 - More emphasis on multimodality, user-centric design and evaluations
- Encourage collaboration and integration
 - Focus on projects already involving multiple partners and/or requiring joint research and integration efforts
- Community building
 - Keep building a lasting IM2 community
 - Im2 support for new, related activities...
 - AIM2

IM2 Phase III (2010-2013): Design

- Consolidation of most of the IM2 activities in one single IP to further foster collaboration and focus (IP1)
- More emphasis on human-centered design and evaluation (IP2):
 - Testing generalization properties of IM2 results (IP1) on different application domains
 - Developing more user-centric applications and evaluation protocols (required new partners)
- Extend fundamental research in one of the newest, but most promizing, (longer-term) outcomes of IM2-II (IP3):
 - Social signal processing (in relation with EU SSPNet and PetaMedia Networks of Excellence)
